<u>English</u>

<u>Vear R Phonics</u>. The children will be learning their initial and double phonemes (end of phase 2 and phase 3) as well as learning to read a range of high frequency and tricky words, which will support them in their reading. Phonemes will be added to your child's red phonics book each week. Please support your child by practising phonemes at home.

<u>Year 1 Phonics-</u>Your child will continue to revisit the phase 5 phonemes learnt as well as learning the new phase 5 alternative phonemes. E.g. The letter 'a' can make four phonemes-acorn, cat, fast, was. They will also be practising reading and spelling a range of tricky and high frequency words from phase 5.

<u>Reading-</u>Your child will take part in shared reading as well as individual reading at school. It is vital that you hear your child read frequently to help them move forward with their reading. Year 1 children also take part in a weekly guided reading session where they share a range of texts.

<u>Handwriting</u>-Your child takes part in daily sessions which involve playdough, paint, glitter and flour as well as more formal work with pencils.

<u>Spellings</u>-Year 1 children have a weekly spelling test. This term spellings include a range of phase 3 and 5 phonemes. Please practise at home for testing on Wednesday mornings.

<u>English</u>- All children will be taking part in our bear related learning. This will involve talk for writing, role play, drama, ordering, letter writing, story writing, captions, recounts and leaflet making.

<u>Maths.</u>

YR – Number recognition to 20, 1 more/less, addition, subtraction, number writing, shapes, patterns, time, days of the week, measures.

Y1-Doubles, halves, days of the week, months of the year, time, shape, number recognition, place value, addition, subtraction, early multiplication and measures.

Computing

Children will be creating favourites lists to add information finding. They will be directing bear bots to move around the classroom too.

Year 1 children have a weekly computer session with Miss Bird.

Understanding of the World

<u>Science</u>-We will be looking at animals starting with those in the school environment. We hope to find out about our favourite animals and this will include a special school trip!

<u>Geography</u>-We will be exploring the human and physical features of our local area. We might even find a bear on our travels!

<u>History</u>-We will be finding out about the history of the story 'We're going on a bear hunt'.

<u>R.E</u>- We will be thinking about the question 'Why is a church important to Christian people?'

We will be thinking about ourselves and our relationships with others.
