Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope you will find this Governor Newsletters helpful. This term Councillor Fred Yeulett's term of office comes to an end, he is a Local Authority Governor and the term of office is four years. We are incredibly pleased Fred has requested to remain on the governing body for another term of office, this request will go to the next full governing body meeting.

We have some exciting news about the class structure in September 2017. The school will be trialling a four class structure for the academic year, until July 2018. There will be four classes and the Pre-School.

Miss Lavender will be teaching the Reception children in the mobile classroom adjoining Pre-School.

Miss Butler will be teaching Year 1 and 2, in what is currently class 1. She will be job sharing with Mrs Williams.

Mrs Ford will be teaching Year 3 and 4, in the current class 2 room.

Mrs Culyer is returning on a part time basis, she will be job sharing with Mrs Williams and together they will be teaching Year 5 and 6, in the current class 3.

As a result of this restructure our current class names are no longer appropriate for four classes and Pre-School. Your input in deciding on new class names would be valued so we are holding a competition to decide on the new names. It might be nice for the names to have a theme, for example a link to Christchurch or the Fens, or maybe authors, local wildlife, you decide. We need four or five, depending on whether you think Pre-School should change its name too. The winning entry will see their names selected for the classes in September.
