Our Topic

This term our topic is based around the question 'What impact does science have on our everyday lives?' If you can help your child/ren with some research at home to share with the class that would be fantastic.

Maths

In Maths, we are following Power Maths schemes. These schemes are designed to develop mastery of mathematical concepts. This means that we will be working on only a few areas of maths for longer periods of time and taking the work to greater depth and using it in more challenging contexts. The areas of study will be decimals, percentages, geometry and measure. The children will receive homework linked to their maths learning in class so that you can see what your child is learning. We practise our timetables in class daily using Rock Star Times Tables. The children all have their own login to access the online resources both in school and at home. Regular practise is very important.

English

In English we will focus our learning on letters, explanations, persuasive writing and narratives, with a focus on the horror genre at the request of the children. All of this will include them developing their joined (cursive) handwriting and working towards gaining pen licenses.

English also covers daily spelling, phonics, punctuation and grammar. Spellings continue to be personalised with each child having their own spellings. These will be tested each Friday and new spellings given out. The children will have opportunities to practise in school but it is vital that they practise at home using their preferred cued spelling method.

Children will all receive at least two guided reading sessions a week and we aim to hear each child read regularly too.

Geography

We will focus on developing our fieldwork, mapping and orienteering skills this term. The children will also be learning about the physical and human features of Greece as well as developing their locational knowledge.

History

We will travel back in time to learn all about Ancient Greece, studying Greek life and achievements and their influence on the western world.

Science

We will be focussing on forces, they will learn how unsupported objects fall towards the Earth because of the force of gravity acting between the Earth and the falling object, identify the effects of air resistance, water resistance and friction, that act between moving surfaces, recognise that some mechanisms, including levers, pulleys and gears, allow a smaller force to have a greater effect. Energy wise the children will learn about different stores of energy and how they affect our lives. . We will complement our learning with a visit to Ely Cathedral where we will take part in Energy Live! Through lively, fire based demonstrations we take the intimidation out of the terminology around energy.

R.E.

The children will be learning about Humanism this term in R.E. We will examine the difference between religious and non-religious worldviews. The origins of humanism, its core beliefs and the meaning of the happiness symbol will also be explored.

P.E.

Each day we will be walking/running the golden mile. On Fridays we will work on improving our multi-skills including spatial awareness and game tactics. We will be playing tennis and enjoying athletics. Please make sure trainers are in school everyday. Swimming will begin the last week in June.

Art

In Art, we will be working on developing skills and linking our art to our history,
